

In addition to the attached information in this email, I wanted to highlight some additional things:

NEW ENTRANCE, MAIN OFFICE, TRAFFIC PATTERN

Starting on August 23rd, we will be, once again, using the front/main entrance off Holt Ave. Parents should enter from the West entrance (first driveway), drop off your child/ren, and exit from the church entrance driveway. To avoid any traffic from people coming to the 8am Mass, all students should arrive no later than 7:45am. This will also ensure that students are one time for morning prayer and assembly.

After school, the students will meet at the main entrance. Parents have two options for pick-up:

- 1) Drive-up pick up. NO PARKING ALLOWED in the front entrance area.
- 2) Park & Pick-up. You can park in a church or school parking space and walk to the entrance.

In addition to this change, our school office will now be located in the previous main office which is a few steps from the main entrance. To enter the school during school hours, please press the buzzer to the right of the metal entrance gate and you will be buzzed in.

DAY CARE CHANGES, INFORMATION, & AFTER-SCHOOL PICKUP

Day Care will begin on Wednesday August 23rd. Starting this year we will no longer be offering morning day care. However, students may arrive at 7:15am and will be under supervision in the courtyard.

Day care is offered every school day, after school, until 6pm.

After school, to pick-up students, parents would use the buzz-in system previously used as the main entrance to school. You press the buzzer and you will be directed to the day-care room and buzzed in.

Make sure that your FACTS account is set up. If you are having issues please make an appointment to come into the office for assistance. A payment plan must be established to attend the first day of school.
